A Dash lift with the Upper Rail cut completed as-well

Having looked at the upper rail dash roll page, carrying out a dash roll with cuts to the upper rail, we have carried out the same upper rail cuts for the Dash Lift technique.

You can see in these pictures that with a vehicle resting on top, a dash lift was successfully completed a long with cutting the upper rail, this prevented any movement in the top resting vehicle. This is a very useful technique for similar situations, however it does take some time so may not be the best option when time is against you. You will also have to look at the issue of space and access to the upper rail to carry out this evolution. The set up is the same for a dash lift except the upper rail is also cut prior to the lift.
